BEUVRY. 22/5/15	Burial of Pte H. Watney in Parish churchyard. Capt. V. S. D. A. Wilkins, Capt. R. H. Archbold, & Lieut. R. A. Berry admitted to hospital suffering from concussion, through explosion of shell. Officers did reconnaissance in trenches at GIVENCHY.	
-- 23/5/15	Divine service under Company arrangements.	
24/5/15	Battalion left at 2 p.m. by Companies & relieved 22 nd Bn. London Regt in trenches at GIVENCHY. 'C' Company fire trenches, 'D' Coy. in support, 'A' & 'B' Coys. in reserve. Bn. Hdqrs. at WINDY CORNER.	
GIVENCHY 25/5/15	Orders received in afternoon that Batta. was to attack German trench at J. 7, 200 yards S. Casualties 499, including 3 Officers killed & 10 wounded.	See Appendix I
-- 26/5/15	Batta. relieved from captured German trench by 20 th Bn. The London Regt. & commenced to leave trenches at 3 p.m. Marched to LE QUESNOL & billeted. Lieut. F. Entwistle appointed to command No. 1 Coy (A & B Coys. amalgamated)	
LE QUESNOL. 27/5/15	Names of 122 men received from Division as being buried.	
-- 28/5/15	Batta. addressed by Gen. Sir C. C. Munro, accompanied by Major-Gen. Batters, G.O.C. 47 th (London) Division.
