- 1st. Remained in Trenches. No casualties - Normal.
- 2nd. Remained in Trenches. 2 O.R wounded. Normal.
- 3rd. Remained in Trenches - No casualties - Normal. 2 Lieut H.J. BUIST to R.F. Corps.
- 4th. Division on left attacked - Demonstration on Battalion Front with Rockets - 5-18 am to 5-36 a.m. considerable Hostile shelling - casualties 2nd Lieut. H.H.S. JONES. Killed. 2 O.R. Killed 2 O.R. wounded. Relieved by 2nd Bn. R.A. Fusiliers. Relief commenced 6 p.m. completed 7.45 p.m. Battalion went into SUPPORT-A and C and 2 B Coy. Battn H.Q. MAUD AVENUE 2 B Coy CLERY CHATEAU (H 12. b) D Coy. 2nd Line (H 10 b and d).
- 5th. Battalion was relieved by 1st Cameronians. Relief commenced 6 pm completed 7.45 pm and proceeded to Camp. 19 (G 16. b.) Casualties 1 O.R. wounded. Draft of 14 O.R. from Base.
